Medical History

We ask for this information in order to make any reasonable adjustments needed to ensure that any impairment or disability will not adversely affect a student's performance on or enjoyment of a course. In the event that, even after full exploration and implementation of possible fair and reasonable adjustments, the impairment of an applicant is considered incompatible with the content and demands of the course as delivered by the Boat Building Academy then the application to join the course will be refused. Any information given by applicants will be kept in the administration office which only the Principal and Administrators have access. While we will do our best to hold this information as confidential and deal with it sensitively, we may, in certain circumstances, need to discuss the matter with members of staff relevant to training. Information will not be disclosed to or discussed with anyone without good reason. The information will be kept no longer than necessary and then destroyed.

Safety

The safety of our people is a prime concern and all those who use our premises must abide by Health and Safety rules and our Health and Safety policy. Only fully briefed and authorised persons may operate the machines. A list of authorised users is held. Normal industry accepted working practices should be followed when using hand tools.

Equal opportunities

The Boat Building Academy is opposed to all forms of direct or indirect discrimination on the grounds of colour, religion/beliefs, learning needs, national group, ethnic, cultural or national origins, traveller, refugee or asylum seeker status, disability, age, marital status, family responsibility, gender, sexual orientation, social position, trade union activity, unrelated criminal convictions or other irrelevant criteria not justified in law.

Admissions

The BBA reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone we consider unsuited to the course and also to discontinue tuition for anyone not prepared to abide by the Centre's safety rules or equality and diversity policy.

Fees

Interviews are not required for short courses, but applicants are welcome to visit beforehand if they wish. The course fee should be forwarded with your application form to reserve a place on the course.

Payment details

Cancellations

In the event of cancellation your payment less a £50 fee per course will be refunded if we receive your cancellation at least one month before the course commences. If you cancel 15 days or less before the course, we cannot refund your money. The Boat Building Academy reserves the right to cancel courses and return fees. For this reason, we advise students to buy refundable airline tickets or flight insurance as the Boat Building Academy will not be responsible for any loss on travel or accommodation costs.

Syllabus and Tutors

The course timetable and the content of the entire course in the programme will be followed as closely as practicable but variations may occur in order to ensure that the overall aims of the course are achieved. The advertised tutors may be changed.

Changes in Circumstances outside the Control of the Boat Building Academy

If circumstances outside the control of the Academy require the BBA to revise the terms, content or delivery of courses from those set out; or discontinue, suspend, merge or combine options within courses; or introduce new options, the BBA will give you as much notice as possible.

These circumstances may include the lack of availability of key personnel without whom the BBA cannot provide its services; under-demand from students which would limit the student learning experience; changes in the requirements of a commissioning or accrediting body; other events such as the building and facilities being unusable; restrictions imposed due to epidemics or pandemics; government restrictions; civil unrest; severe weather; failure of essential public; private services.
