Terms of Business - Boat Building Academy Short Courses

Medical History

We ask for this information in order to make any reasonable adjustments needed to ensure that any impairment or disability will not adversely affect a student's performance on or enjoyment of a course. In the event that, even after full exploration and implementation of possible fair and reasonable adjustments, the impairment of an applicant is considered incompatible with the content and demands of the course as delivered by the Boat Building Academy then the application to join the course will be refused. Any information given by applicants will be kept in the administration office in a filing cabinet to which only the Principal and Administrators have access. While we will do our best to hold this information as confidential and deal with it sensitively we may, in certain circumstances, need to discuss the matter with members of staff relevant to training. Information will not be disclosed to or discussed with anyone without good reason. The information will be kept no longer than necessary and then destroyed.

Safety

The safety of our people is a prime concern and all those who use our premises must abide by Health and Safety rules and our Health and Safety policy. Only fully briefed and authorised persons may operate the machines. A list of authorised users is held. Normal industry accepted working practices should be followed when using hand tools.

Equal opportunities

Admissions

The BBA reserves the right to refuse admission to anyone we consider unsuited to the course and also to discontinue tuition for anyone not prepared to abide by the Centre's safety rules or equality and diversity policy.

Fees

Interviews are not required for short courses but applicants are welcome to visit beforehand if they wish. The course fee should be forwarded with your application form to reserve a place on the course.

Payment details

Payments may be made by cheque (payable to Boat Building Academy Ltd), bank transfer, debit or credit card. If you pay by credit card it attracts a 2.5% charge by the credit card company. Please return your payment with this completed application form and the payment details form which will be destroyed once your payment is taken.

Cancellations

In the event of cancellation, your payment less a £50 fee per course will be refunded if we receive your cancellation at least one month before the course commences. If your notice of cancellation is received between 15 and 30 days prior to the course we will refund your fee less £50 on condition that the course is filled (it is deemed full when eight students are enrolled, with the exception of 'Modern Boat Building' 'Sail Making' and 'Chair Making' which are deemed full when six students are enrolled and 'Basic Woodworking' which is deemed full when ten students are enrolled). If you cancel 15 days or less before the course we cannot refund your money. In case of emergency or an insufficient number of students, the Boat Building Academy reserves the right to cancel a course and return fees. For this reason we advise students to buy refundable airline tickets or flight insurance as the Boat Building Academy will not be responsible for any loss on travel or accommodation costs.

Syllabus and Instructors

The course timetable and the content of the entire course in the programme will be followed as closely as practicable but variations may occur in order to ensure that the overall aims of the course are achieved. The advertised instructors may be changed.
